Please note: Case reports are not accepted. Editorials are by invitation only. All studies must be relevant to radiology practice.

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Requirements

- Word count <3000
- Structured abstract <250 words
- Main manuscript document should use IMRAD structure (Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion)
- References ≤ 35
- Tables: Up to 4 with clear legends
- Figures: Up to 6 figure parts, including charts and graphs, with clear legends and arrows if appropriate.

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Review articles cover the existing state of understanding in a specific research area or topic.

Requirements

- Word count: <4000
- Abstract: <250 words
- References ≤80
- Tables: Up to 4 with clear legends
- Figures: Up to 20 figure parts, including charts and graphs, with clear legends and arrows if appropriate.

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Research letters are original research articles presented as focused reports. Letters must not duplicate other material published or submitted for publication. They will be peer-reviewed in the same manner as Original Research articles.

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- No abstract
- Use IMRAD structure (Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion)
- References ≤6
- Tables: 1, with clear legend
- Figures: Up to 2 figure parts, with clear legends and arrows if appropriate.

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- No more than 4 authors, and their affiliations must appear at the end of the letter.
- References: No more than 6
- No figures, no tables

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
