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Book reviews should be approximately between 800-1,200 words long, while the review essay could be 2000-3000 words long.

As part of this commitment, we invite the submission of Replication Studies, which can focus on research previously published in this journal or other prominent academic journals. Replication Studies play a vital role in ensuring the credibility, reliability, and robustness of scientific findings. Submissions will be evaluated primarily based on their methodological rigor and the degree to which they clearly replicate the original study, rather than the novelty of their theoretical contributions.

We recognize two primary categories of replication studies, each with specific submission requirements and expectations:

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Replication studies conducted by the original authors of the research are capped at a maximum of 4,000 words excluding bibliography and Appendices. These submissions provide an opportunity for the original authors to clarify, reinforce, or further contextualize their findings.
