

## Journal of Interpersonal Violence

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**Original research article: Description:** JIV only publishes reports on individual studies in which the scientific method is applied to the study of some aspect of interpersonal violence. JIV does not publish reviews of research, individual case studies, or conceptual analyses of aspects of interpersonal violence.

**Length limit:** No longer than 30 double-spaced pages in 12 point Times New Roman font, including references, tables, and figures. (Tables and figures do not have to be double spaced.) Brief Notes must be no longer than 12 double-spaced pages, inclusive.

**Abstract:** No longer than 250-300 words, including a summary of study questions, subjects, methods, findings, and major implications.

**Style guide:** Must be formatted according to the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (7th edition).

**Format:** All files must be submitted as Microsoft Word documents (not PDFs). A title page, main document (including references), tables, figures, author biographies, and any supplemental material should be uploaded as separate files.

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For clinical trials, the trial registry name and URL, and registration number must be included at the end of the abstract.

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
