

## MOVIES/ANIMATIONS

Supplementary movies or animation files should be provided in one of the formats listed in the table below. It is recommended that you adhere to the submission of material in the specified 'preferred' formats.

Supplying material in one of the formats outlined below will ensure the best chance of the users being able to access, view or play the data, both now and in the future.

Any alternative format supplied may be subject to conversion (if technically possible) prior to online publication.

### Recommended File Size Limits

For ease of download, the suggested file size is 1 Mb. The maximum file size of a single multimedia or audio file is 10 Mb. When the size of a single file is bigger than this, some users may experience problems when downloading. Whenever possible, this limit should be adhered to.

## AUDIO FILES

Supplementary audio files should be provided in the format listed below. Any alternative format supplied may be subject to conversion (if technically possible) prior to online publication.

Supply of material in one of the formats outlined below will ensure that the majority of potential users have the best chance of being able to access, view or play the data, both now and in the future.

## Recommended File Size Limits

For ease of download, the suggested file size is 1 Mb. The maximum file size of a single multimedia or audio file is 10 Mb. When the size of a single file is bigger than this, some users may experience problems when downloading. Whenever possible, this limit should be adhered to.

## Submission Instructions

1. Include a README file (in ASCII or PDF format) with the multimedia material. The README file must be submitted as a PDF or text document in order to be accessible to the widest audience.
2. The author should provide the title of the file, the author and article name, and a text description to be included next to the video or audio file.
3. Please notify the EIC or the staff editor when a paper will contain multimedia or audio. The earlier in the process we can make sure all the requirements are met, the less likelihood there will be delays.
