



Special Issue: Twice-Exceptionality Manuscripts; *Gifted Child Quarterly* Call for Proposals

Gifted Child Quarterly (GCQ) is planning a special issue on twice-exceptionality for the fall 2013 issue and is seeking proposals for manuscripts. For the special issue, we will define twice-exceptional as possessing high levels of talent in one or more domains as well as a mental, emotional, or physical disability. We are most interested in empirical articles but will also consider review and theoretical papers. The deadline for proposal submissions is September 1, 2012. Proposals should include a title and a 100 – 250 word abstract, names of authors, and contact information for the corresponding author.

The timeline for this special issue is as follows:

- Proposals for manuscripts due on September 1, 2012
- Authors notified of proposal acceptance no later than October 1, 2012 (Please note that acceptance of a proposal does not guarantee acceptance of submitted manuscripts.)
- Manuscripts due no later than January 7, 2013
- Reviews and action letters to authors by March 1, 2013
- Revising and editing process during the following two to three months
- Final accepted manuscripts completed and returned to guest editor by May 1, 2013
- Authors review proofs of articles- summer 2013
- Issue published in GCQ 57:4, October 2013
